Applicant must:

- Have current CPR/First Aid certification.
- Have excellent verbal and good written communication skills as well as the ability to use existing technology to achieve desired results.
- Be able to manage risk responsibly, assess consequences or decisions prior to action
- Utilize knowledge and creativity in developing progressive lesson plans
- Have strong and clear communication skills
- Have ability to build constructive and effective relationships internally and externally
- Have ability to maintain composure under pressure

This position requires moderate to strenuous physical exertion and/ or physical strain. Applicant should be able to lift at least 30 lbs, and assist riders weighing up to 200+ lbs with mounts and dismounts This position involves occasional exposure to disagreeable weather conditions, and may require evening and/or weekend work
